- Proof of PPS Number: Payslip, P60, Revenue correspondence, Old Social Services Card

Applications for Joint accounts and Juvenile accounts (< 16 years of age) must be made in person in any of our 4 offices. For further information please see our website; www.mylimerickcu.ie/join-us. If you are unsure whether you are eligible for membership, please contact the credit union.

Suggested addition to web site membership requirements:

Non-EU and Non-Common Travel Area applicants

- Passport of current nationality
- Residence permit/GNIB card, front & back
- Proof of Address: An original utility bill, bank statement or social welfare document, dated within 6 months
- Proof of PPS Number: Payslip, P60, Revenue correspondence, Old Social Services
